

DONOR ADVISED FUND AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT establishes a Donor Advised Fund for _____
(the "Donor") at RTS Foundation, Inc. (the "Foundation"), an organization that is tax exempt
under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

1. The Donor Advised Fund. The Donor hereby establishes

- an Endowment Donor Advised (EDA) Fund or
 a Regular Donor Advised (RDA) Fund as a component part of the Foundation.

2. Procedures. The Donor has received a copy of the RTS Foundation, Inc. Procedures for
Donor Advised Funds, and agrees that those Procedures will govern the Fund.

3. Name. The Fund will be called the _____ Donor Advised Fund.

4. Purposes. The exempt purposes of the Fund, like those of the Foundation, are exclusively
religious, charitable, educational, literary, and scientific, and further specified in Article
II of the Procedures for Donor Advised Funds. Recommendations and distributions
must exclusively further these exempt purposes. In order to protect the integrity of the
Foundation, the Board of Trustees is appointed by Reformed Theological Seminary, and may
from time to time approve donor recommendations for grants to the Seminary.

5. Signatures During Life. During the Donor's life, the signature of one or two Donors
will be required to recommend distributions.

6. Recommendations After Death(s). After the Donor dies (or if there are two Donors after
they both die), recommendations may be made by a. below, or a. and b. jointly. If a. and b.
are serving jointly, and one dies, the survivor shall make recommendations individually.
Both a. and b. must be at least 21 years of age as of the date of this Agreement.
